**Housing Mix and Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning  
Document Adoption Statement**

The Housing Mix and Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by Melton Borough Council on 9<sup>th</sup> July 2019.

The SPD provides guidance to the Local Plan (2011 – 2036) policies: C2 (Housing Mix); C4 (Affordable Housing Provision) and C5 (Affordable Housing through Rural Exception Sites). It will also be a material consideration in determining planning applications.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the supplementary planning document was adopted; which is the 9th October 2019.
